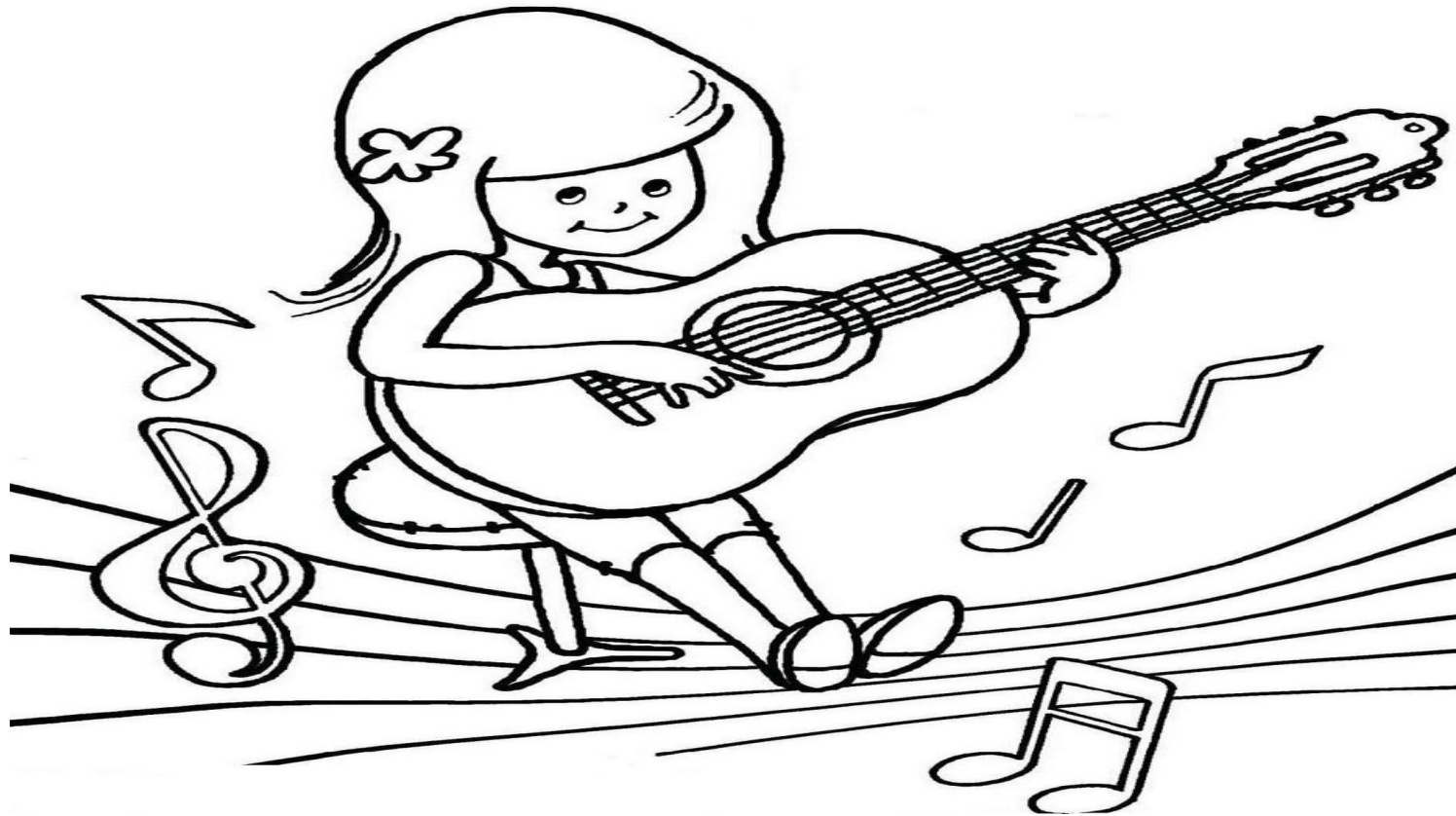

Instrument families

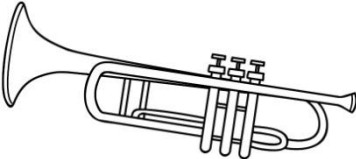
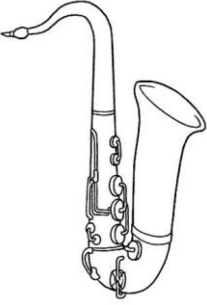
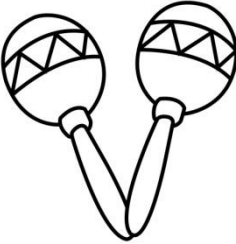
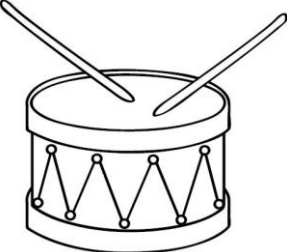
There are *three types* of musical instrument families
